Sankey Diagrams of UGS Student Migration Across UT for Students Entering in 2012 and 2013 Broken Down by Race

These Sankey diagrams were constructed from IRRIS student data for UGS students entering in the 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 academic years. Student outcomes are reported for students graduating as late as the 2018-2019 academic year, although the majority of students graduated in four years. External transfer students are included along with first time in college (FTIC) students in this dataset. In the Sankey diagrams, the left margin indicates the college or school in which the students entered UT Austin, and the right margin indicates the UT college or school in which the students earned their degrees. The individual student paths were tracked using EID's. The widths of each line in the diagrams are strictly proportional to the number of students represented. 
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UGS Entering 2012 Cohort
