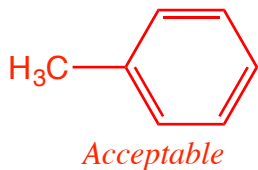
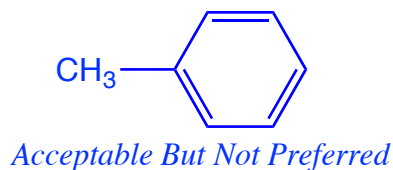
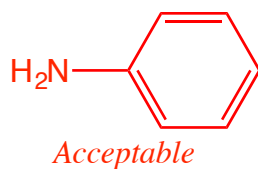
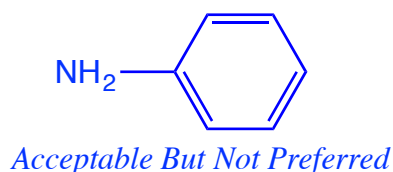
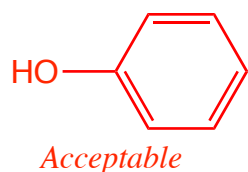
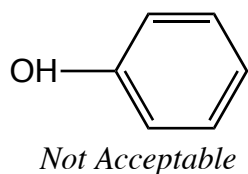
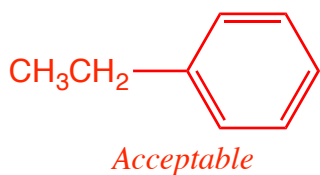
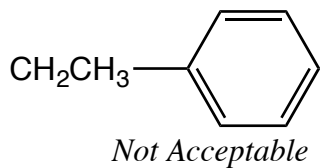


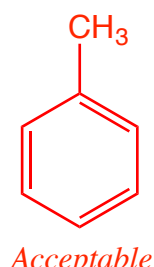
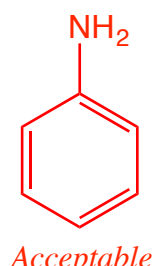
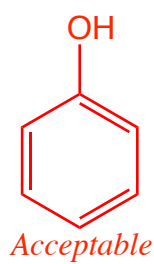
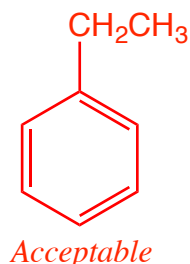
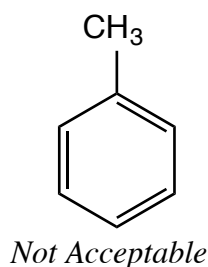
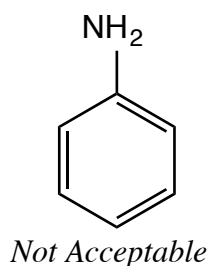
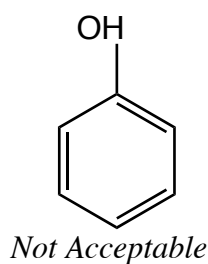
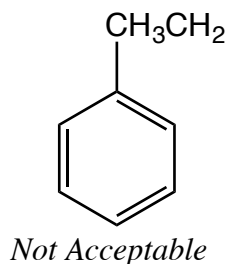
## Labels Do's and Don'ts - location of the bonds and atom labels matter

The simple rule is that you need to make sure each bond is drawn between the atom labels for the atoms actually bonded. The following examples illustrate the main mistakes we have seen and the acceptable way to draw each molecule.
